

Fire Safety with the Pringle Family



For Fire prevention awareness week, Mrs. Pringle invited her husband, Firefighter Sean, and her son, Firefighter Matt to teach our children all about what firefighters do and how to stay safe in a fire emergency. The firefighting Pringle family shared these key home fire escape planning tips:

- Make sure your plan meets the needs of all your family members, including those with sensory or physical disabilities.
- Smoke alarms should be installed inside every sleeping room, outside each separate sleeping area, and on every level-of your home. Smoke alarms should be interconnected so when one sounds, they all sound.
- Know at least two ways out of every room, if possible. Make sure all doors and windows open easily.
- Have an outside meeting place a safe distance from your home where everyone should meet.
- Practice your home fire drill at least twice a year with everyone in the household, including guests. Practice at least once during the day and once at night.



We Love Our Reading Buddies!



We are so happy to have our **Reading Buddies** back! Our volunteers help promote literacy in our kindergarten and first grade classes. They read to the same small groups of students each week throughout the school year using a readaloud format that augments the school's regular reading curriculum. Reading Buddies remains the only in-school program of its kind in Monmouth County.

Reading Buddies' intergenerational approach to reading goes beyond fostering the literacy skills essential to future success. It also provides appropriate role-modeling for young students, builds confidence and mutual respect, and broadens students' understanding of the world around them.

The purpose is to highlight the need for improving screening levels to detect this deadly cancer in its earliest stages and to assist women to take steps to lower their risk of developing cancer. 


