child(ren).



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### Preschool Tree Study Room 100

In our classroom we have been taking care of many different types of trees such as a bonsai tree, a money tree, and even an avocado tree. We taste tested avocados and are in the process of propagating the pits. We measure the circumference of the trunks of the trees on our playground using string and measuring tape. Using Sun butter and birdseed we created pinecone birdfeeders and hung them on the tree outside of our classroom to feed our neighborhood birds. When we return next week the children will be singing a song about planting trees and we hope to even plant a small spruce tree on our playground to take care of throughout the year.
