

The Sustainable New Jersey Grant



In receipt of the grant at the College of New Jersey were: Mr. Joe Grillo, BOE Member, Tiffeny Andrews, Instructional Coach, and Amanda Napolitani, Reading Specialist

Thurgood Marshall Elementary School was awarded a \$2,000 Sustainable Jersey grant funded by the PSEG Foundation. Five \$20,000-grants, 12 \$10,000-grants and 40 \$2,000-grants were distributed to recipients across 17 New Jersey counties. The grant awards will fund a range of projects including food waste recycling; green infrastructure and sustainable landscaping; green fairs; composting; green business recognition; environmental resource inventories; outdoor classrooms; pollinator gardens and so much more!

Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) not only helps students and teachers develop strong relationships when implemented correctly; it also teaches students important skills to help them be successful throughout their life. The way we respond to a child directly after a behavior makes it more or less likely to occur again. This is true of all behaviors, even those you may not want your child to repeat! Reinforcing socially appropriate and positive behaviors with meaningful rewards makes it more likely that children will repeat those desired behaviors.



Here at Thurgood Marshall Elementary School, we work hard to seek out those positive behaviors and reward the students with PBIS tickets that they can use to buy prizes at the store, win larger weekly raffles and mostly recently buy tickets to attend our Thurgood Marshall Movie Theatre where we show a variety of new releases and serve movie theatre treats in a relaxing theatre atmosphere. This addition to our PBIS reward system has been a huge hit with the students and it provides them with some extra incentive to work hard and be good citizens in school!
